To my dear Friends at Harmony School,

This is the fourth year you have invited me to participate in your unconventional, extraordinary, and uniquely creative yearbook.

I'm writing to you from a little farm in the hills of North Carolina, and not from a prison cell as has been the case the last three years. I will never forget those who reached out to me during my imprisonment and gave me a sense of self worth. Perhaps someday I can thank you in person, but, until then, thanks for your kindness from the bottom of my heart.

The mystery theme of this year's book has me intrigued and I'm interested to see how each of you handles the Great Mystery of Life.

The greatest true life mystery I was ever a part of happened to me as a little boy. One night, I was awakened by a loud thunderous sound. I was petrified as the sound came from inside our house. As I lay paralyzed with fear, I could hear the sirens of many police cars. As I got up enough courage to look out the window, I saw them, with their red lights flashing, one by one pull up to my house.

Quickly, I put on my clothes and made my way downstairs. The police had taped off our front yard and were busily looking for clues. They dusted for fingerprints and found a pair of shoes on our front porch that did not belong to anyone in our family. My heart was beating with excitement as my friends began to come to my house to see what was happening.

Each bit of information I could glean I shared with my playmates. I had learned that the great thunderous noise was made by my father, chasing an intruder from his second floor bedroom, and both of them tumbling down the staircase which was located right next to the wall adjoining my bedroom. The police put all the clues together and were able to catch the infamous "barefoot burglar," who had been robbing numerous homes in our town. The newspaper had named him that because he always took off his shoes so he could quietly creep into people's homes in the middle of the night.

As I grew up, I came to realize that the "barefoot burglar" mystery was not the greatest mystery of my life. The truly Great Mystery of Life is how to know who God is and that He loves you and how God has made plans for you to live forever. Jesus Christ said, "Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the Kingdom of God:" (Mark 4:11)

The word "mystery" is used twenty-two times in the New Testament. Paul the Apostle said, "The mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest..." (Colossians 1:26).

If you want to know about God, where He lives, and what His relationship to you is, you will find all the clues to this Great Mystery of Life in God's Word, the Holy Bible.

Perhaps someday I can share with you more of what I have learned about the Great Mystery of Life from God's Word. I care about you. God loves you! He really does!

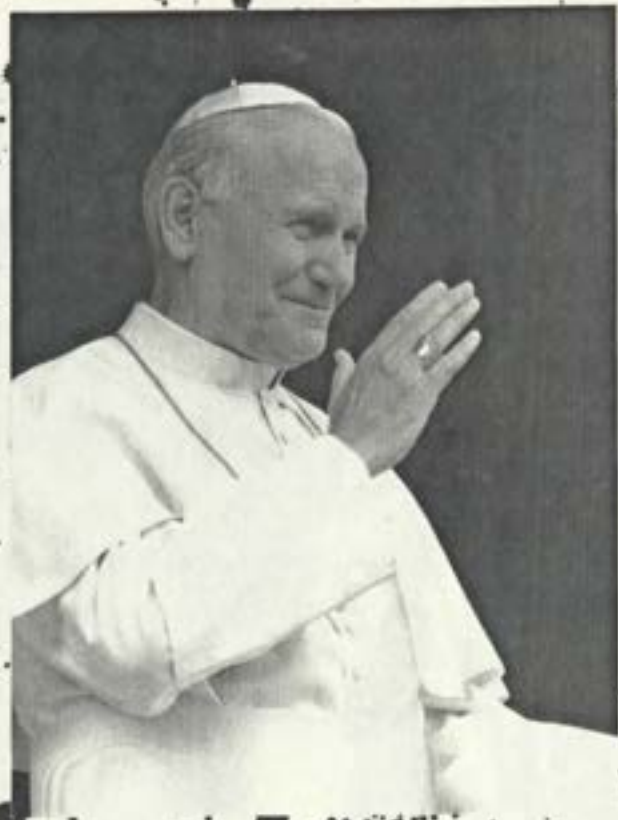

Order--Purely chronological starting with six year olds. The early childhood program is grouped in collage format.

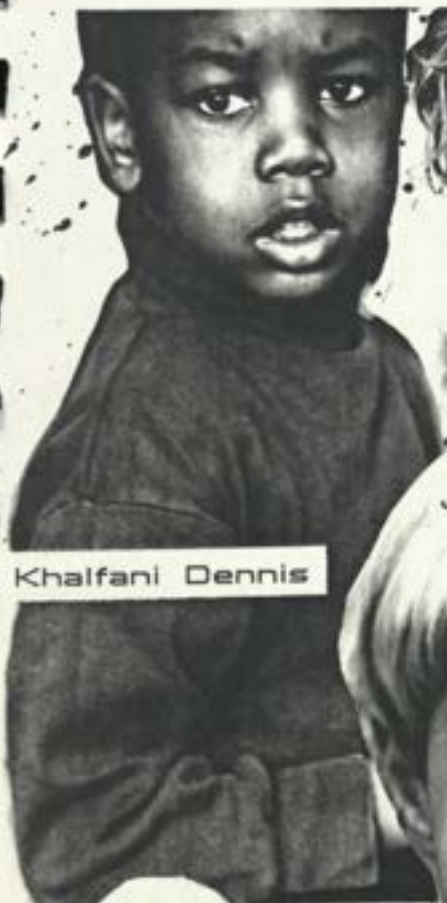

What's Your Most Embarrassing Moment?

Dear Mr. Gizzard,

A few days ago something very funny happened to me. I thought I'd write you to tell you about it. Feel free to print it in your next issue.

Anyway, this embarrassing moment happened to me while I was conducting a science experiment down in the school kitchen. I took some $K_2Cr_2O_7$ (about 0.015 M) and added it to three different alcohols, obviously expecting two of the alcohols to turn blue, and the other to remain yellow. The concept behind this is that potassium dichromate will oxidize propyl alcohol and *sec*-butyl, but not *tert*-butyl.

I proceeded to add about 25 mL of each alcohol (propyl alcohol [1-propanol], *sec*-butyl [2-butanol], and *tert*-butyl alcohol [2-methyl-2-propanol]) to three large test tubes. I then added 25

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mL. of the $K_2Cr_2O_7$ solution to each test tube, give or take a mL., and I stirred like the dickens. Of course, the aldehyde would be further oxidized to form a

carboxylic acid. At least, that's what I expected. But silly me! I'm still to this day not sure what I was thinking, but this is what I ended up doing:

The sugar became dehydrated: $C_{12}H_{22}O_{11} = 12C(\text{graphite}) + 11 H_2O(l)$, and the sulfuric acid became hydrated:

$H_2SO_4 \cdot nH_2O + mH_2O = H_2SO_4 \cdot (n+m)H_2O + \text{heat}$ ($n=11$ moles, $m=11 \times 2.0$ moles of sucrose=22 moles, and $n_1=2.3$ moles).

Geeezz! Where did I leave my head that day. All my colleagues laughed at me and, as you can imagine, my face turned red as an apple. Well I know I'll never do that again. From now on I think I'll just stick to less "abstract" experiments, if you know what I mean!
