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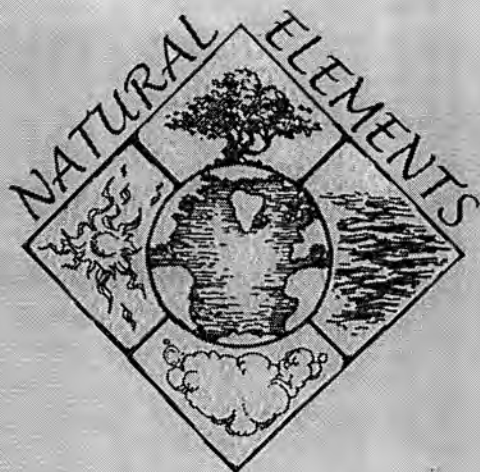


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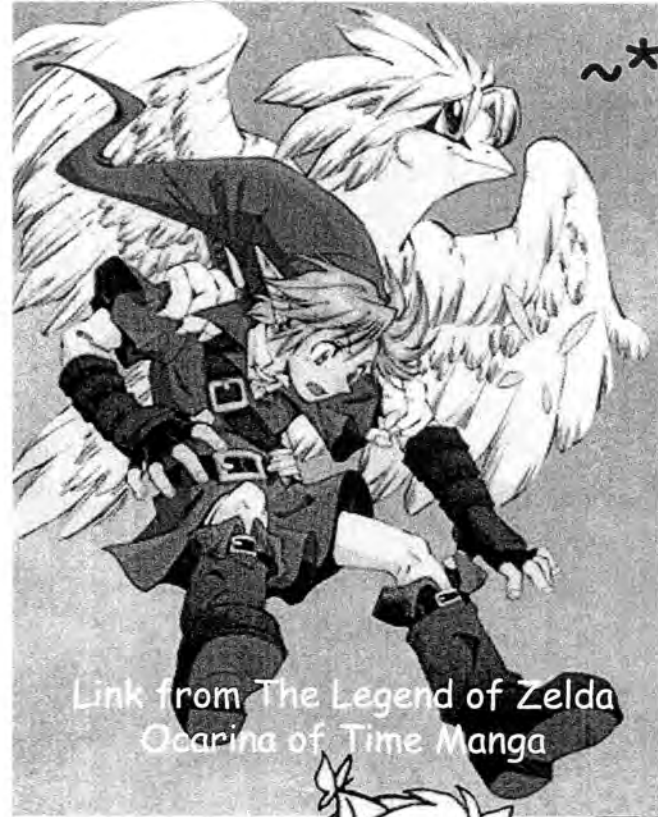
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Dylan Makes Good on Campaign Promise

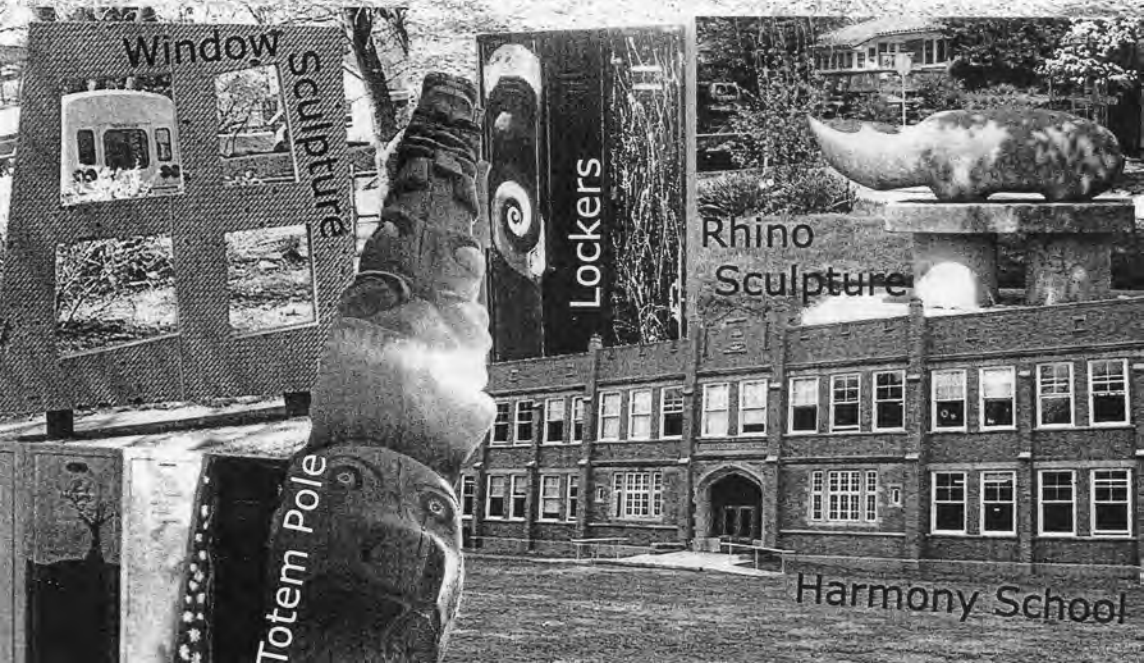

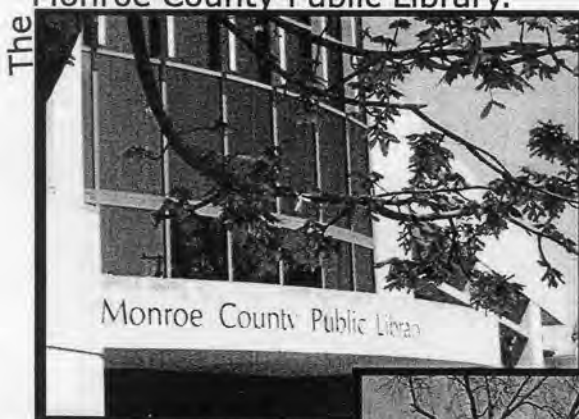

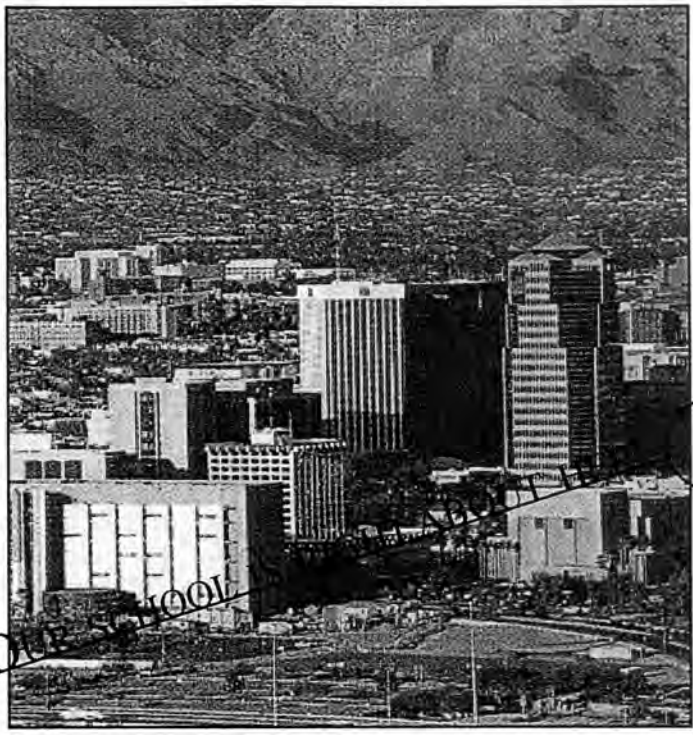

City Works

City Works, is an innovative and academic approach to service learning, in which students collaborate with community organizations to develop and implement projects that benefit the Tucson community. As a result, students in City Works classes gain real-world experience and skills, build character, cultivate a deeper knowledge of their community, and adopt a sense of civic responsibility. The City Works program was launched this year with the important collaboration of a number of community organizations, such as Tucson Fire Department, Pima County Planning Department, University of Arizona Flandrau Science Center, the Southwest Preventive Health Foundation, Fox Tucson Theatre, and Dinnerware Contemporary Arts Gallery.

Some of the long-term City Works projects that students are engaged in during the 2004-2005 school year include:

- Performing science education outreach activities for elementary and middle school students, as well as for others of all ages in the larger community;
- Conducting research and learning from experts in the medical and health fields in order to provide nutrition reports for the school community and their families;
- Exploring the local art scene and creating a book and website on various Tucson artists, in addition to having an exhibition of student work;
- Working with Pima County Planning Department to create digital maps of downtown structures to help the Tucson Fire Department and other first responders in the area, and;
- Assisting the Fox Theatre in archiving their collection and researching its history.
