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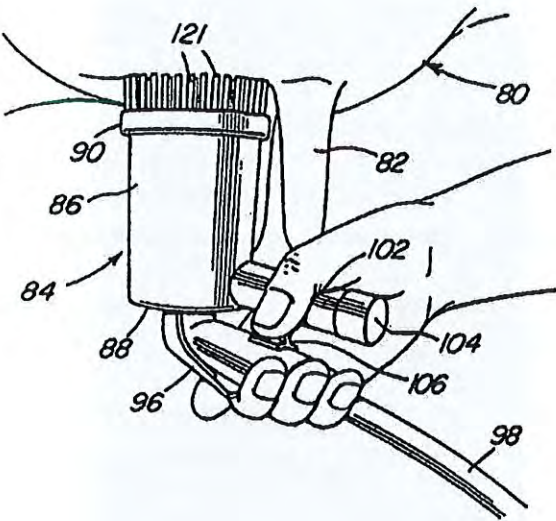

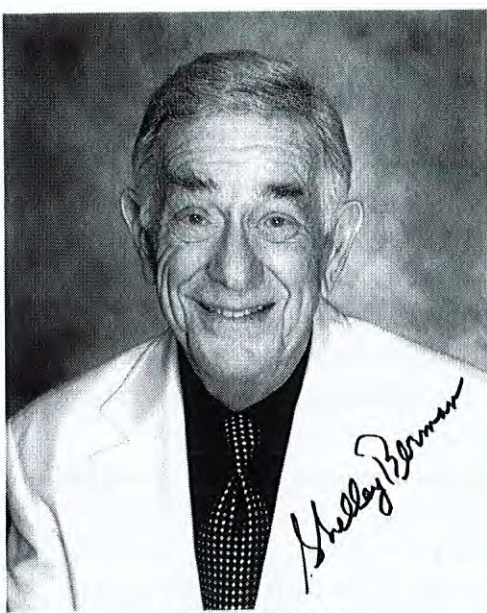

A movement called "the right to be forgotten" has surfaced for people who want to be lost.

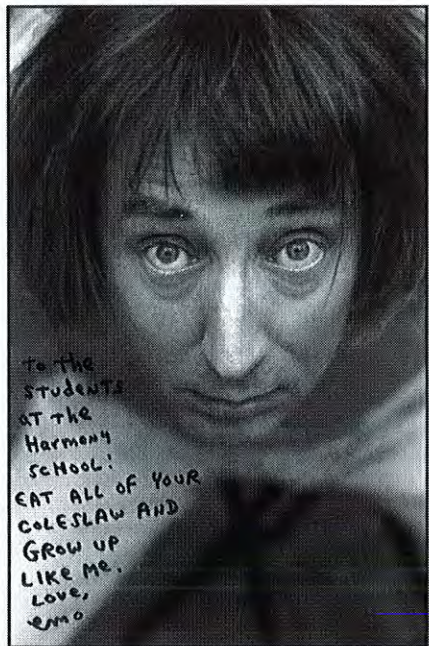

In the history of humankind many languages have been lost or are in the process of becoming extinct. A few selected examples:

- Knaanic, a Slavic language, lost in the late sixteenth century, once spoken in the area of the present-day Czech Republic and Poland.
- Old Prussian, a Baltic language, lost in the early eighteenth century, once spoken in Prussia (a region of modern-day Germany). Sample:

Thawe nuson kas tu asse Andangon, swintits wirst twais Emmens; pergeis twais Laeims; twais Quaits audasseisin na Semmey, key Andangon.

- Crimean Gothic, a Germanic language, lost in the late eighteenth century, once spoken in some isolated regions of Crimea (present-day Ukraine). Sample:

qimai þiudinassus þeins  
wairþai wilja þeins  
swe in himina jah ana airþai.

- Pumpokol, a Yeniseian language, lost in the early nineteenth century, once spoken in central Siberia.
- Nottoway, an Iroquoian language, lost in the 1830s, once spoken in Virginia. Sample:

- Massachusetts, an Algonquian language, lost in the late nineteenth century, once spoken in Massachusetts. Sample:

*Nashum keskqut quttianatamanack hawesaouk. Peyaumautch kukkenau-toomoouk ne a nack okkeet neam keskqut. Nem-meet-sougash asekesuhokesu assnauean yedyee kesu-kod.*

- Dalmatian, Romance language with two main dialects (Ragusan and Vegliot), lost around 1898, once spoken in the Dalmatia region of Croatia. Sample:

- Pochutec, a Uto-Aztecan language, lost around 1915, once spoken in the area of Oaxaca, Mexico.
- Tonkawa, Amerindian language (isolate), lost in the 1930s, once spoken in Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico.

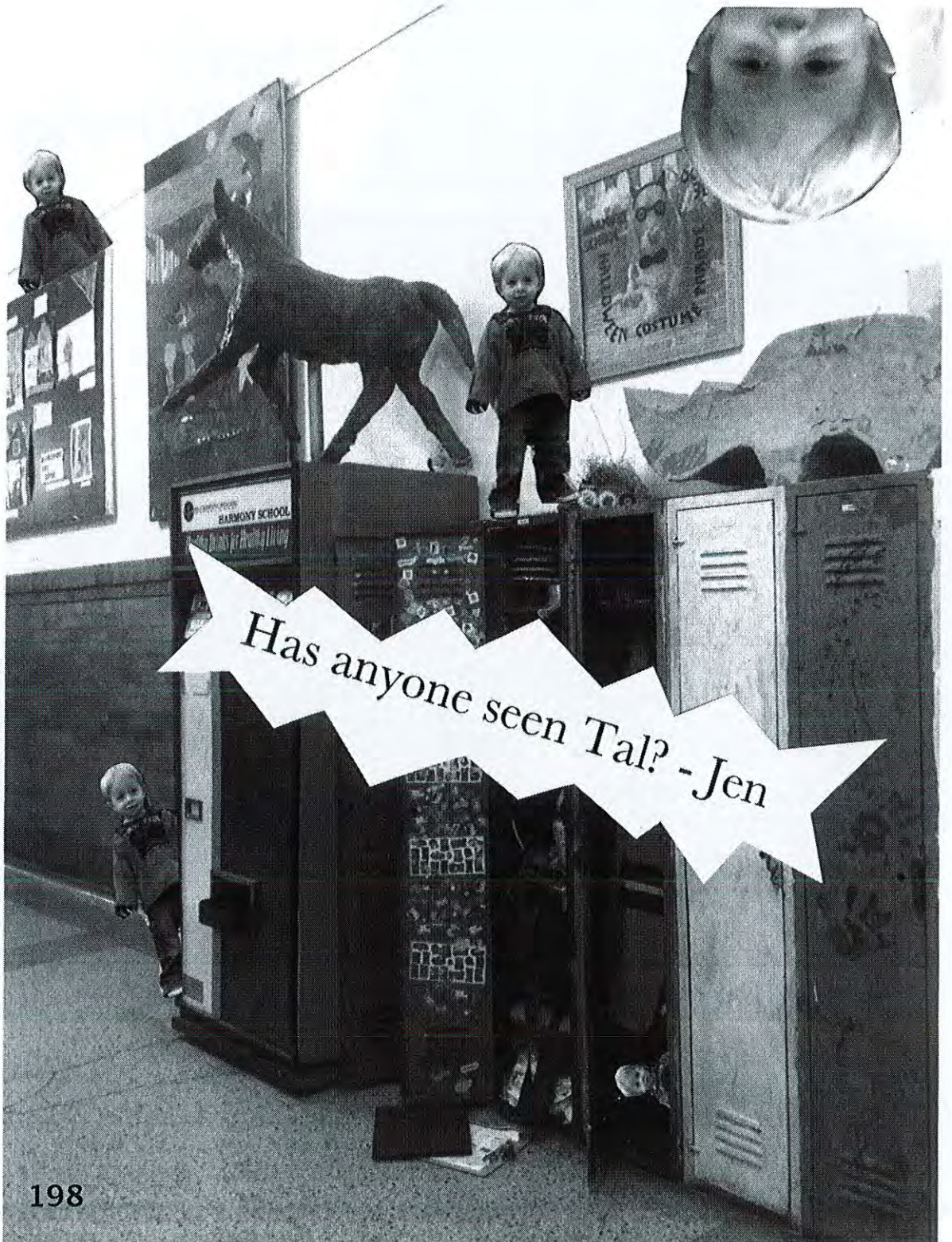

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## Transcript Mix-Up Results in High School Endorsement from American Kennel Club

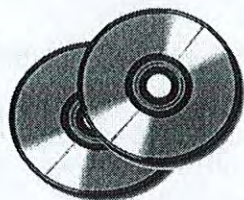

On a more positive note, Preston is now certified as an AKC Golden Retriever. "Hey, it could have been worse," said Preston. "I could have been a poodle."



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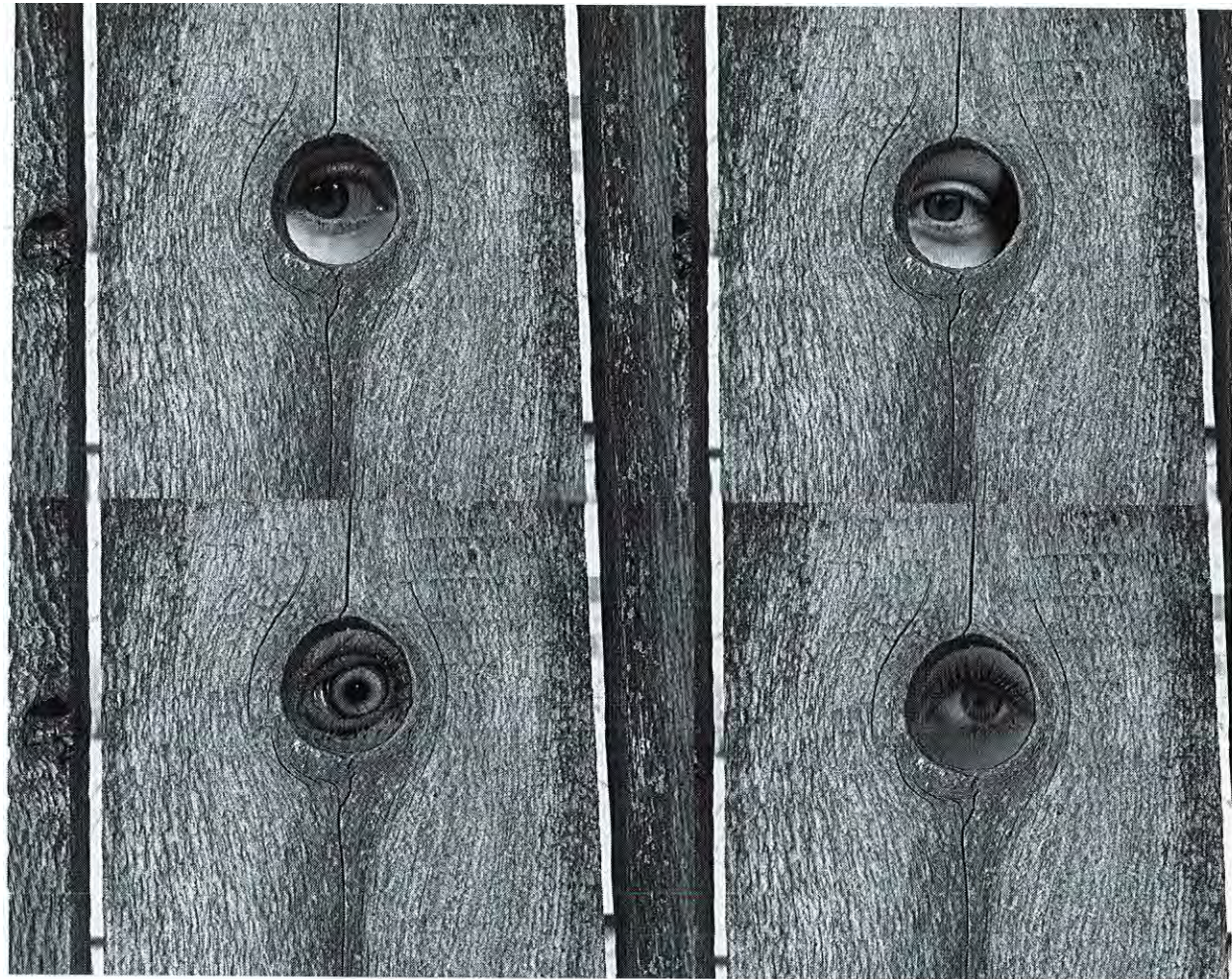

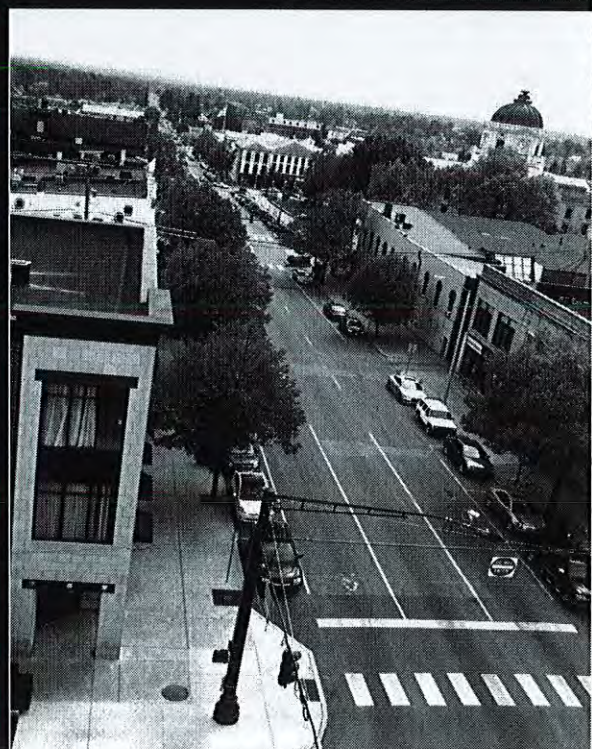


## Sophia Invents Shrink Ray
