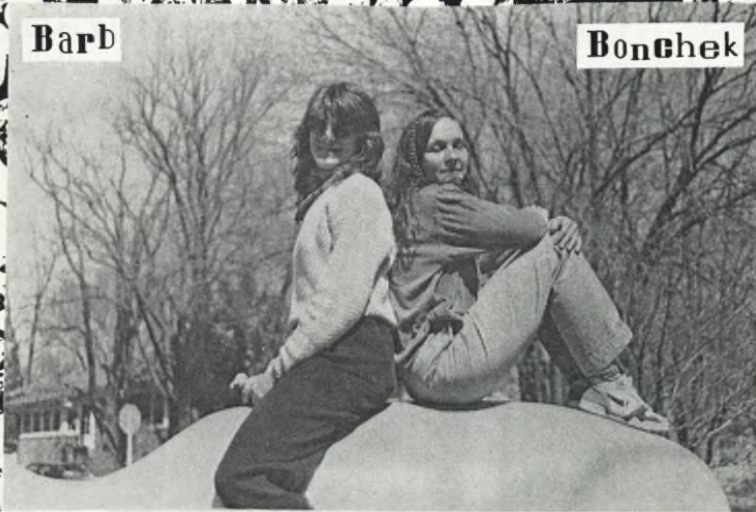
The children actively participate in the fun & games. They are treating each other more sensitivity. I am inspired with the beautiful feelings that have managed to linger on thru another year.

I would hate to be a trash person and have to empty dumpsters and trash cans.

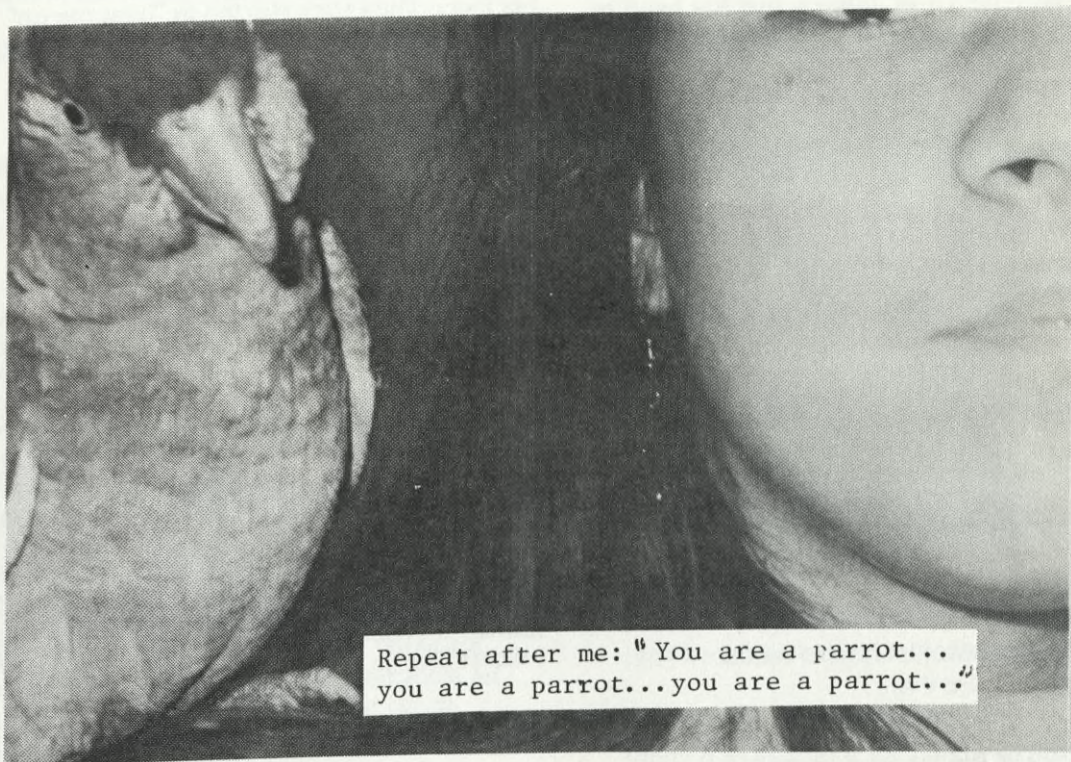
People should recycle everything. If they recycled everything then there would not be any use for ugly dumpsters, incinerators or landfills.

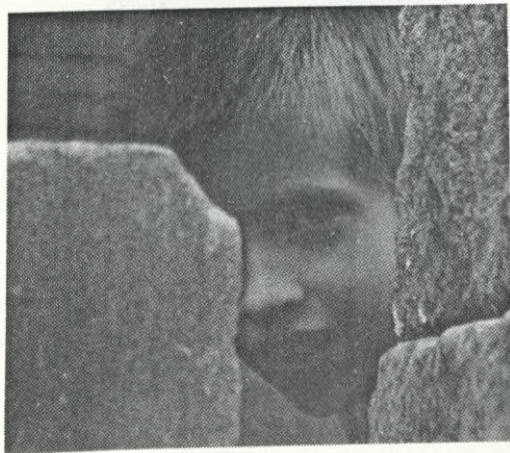

laboratories are selfish and just think about people's future, not animals'. That's not fair.

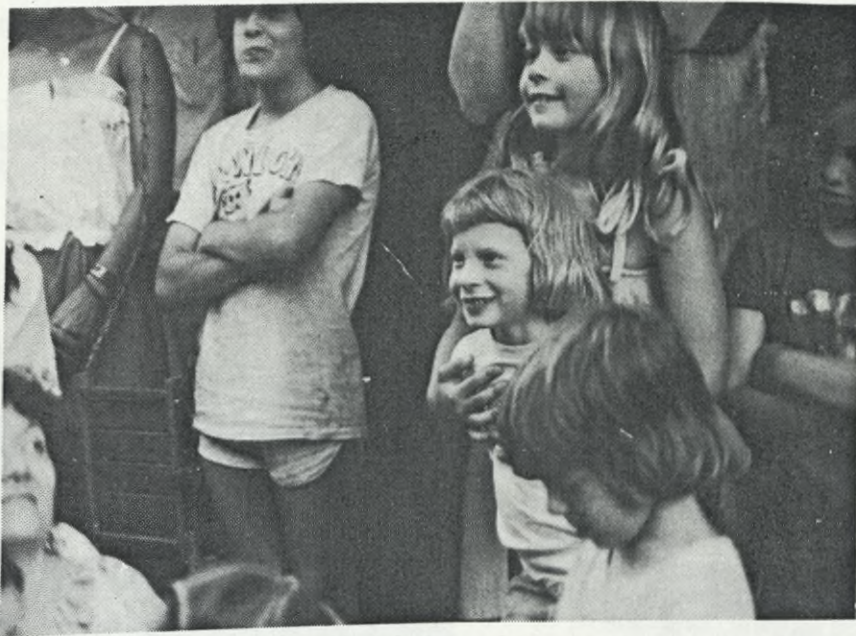

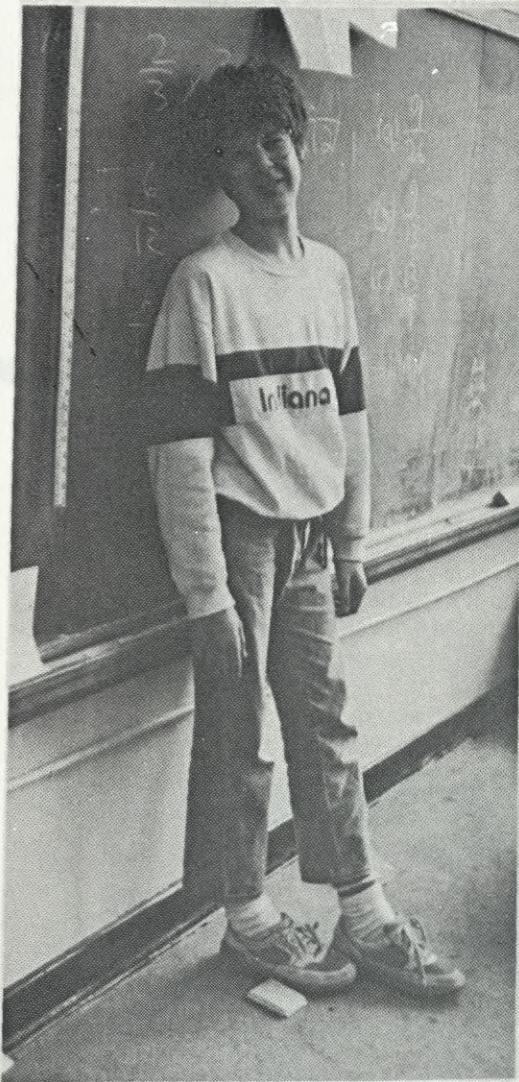

And so Nick's mom gave Nick the dollar. Well, that's how I got my first bath. That's all, folks.

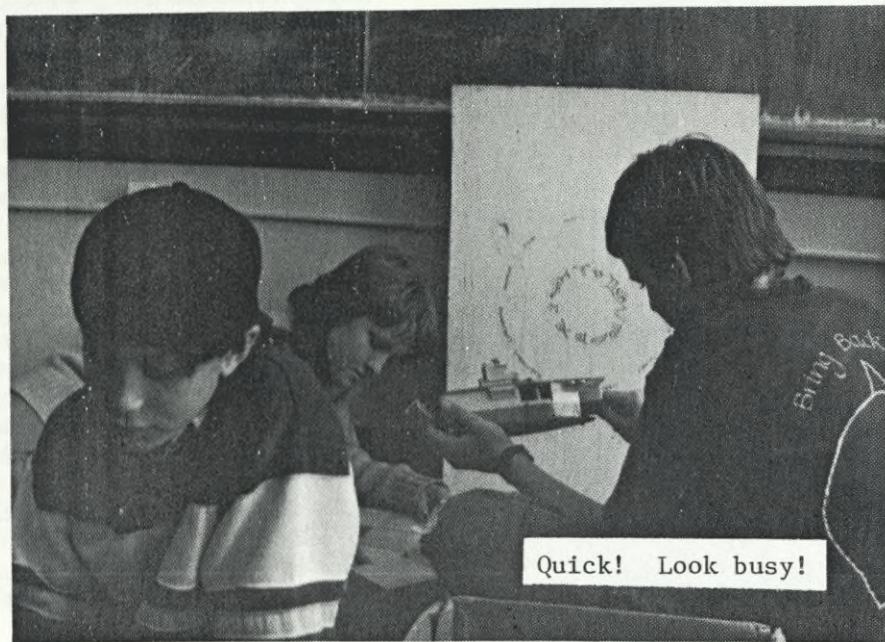
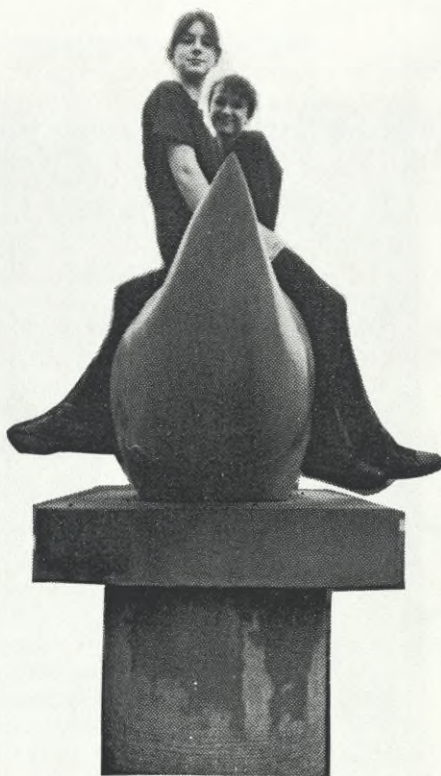

Sarah Thomas Campbell came in the gallery and museum that week and went through who was to have what on her 90th birthday which was on that Thursday.

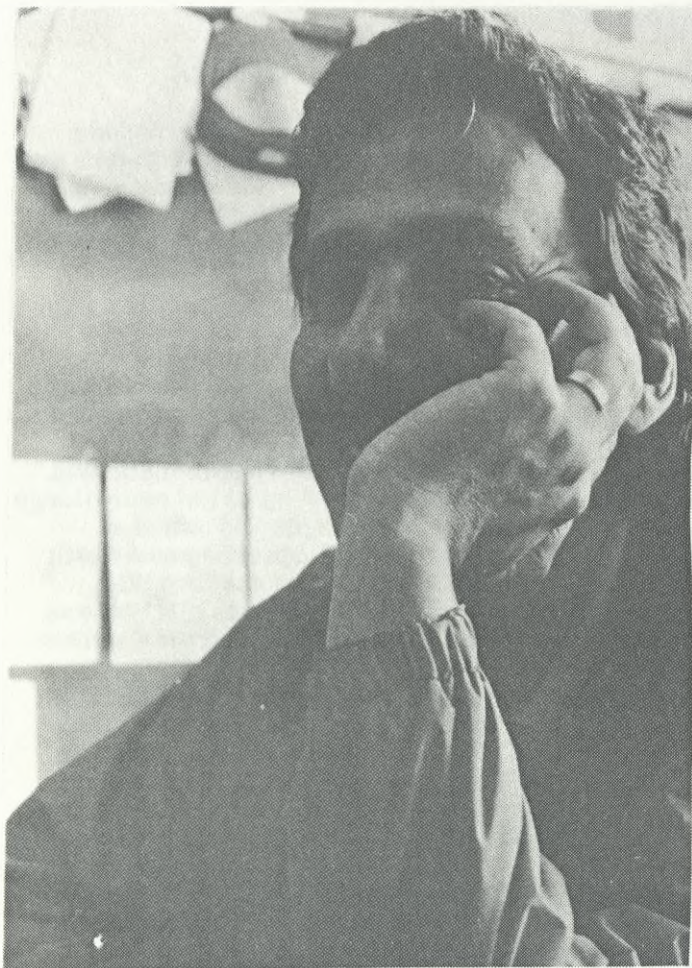
