Then Cheese man hopped in and said, "Evil elves!" So Cheese Man killed all of Santa's elves except one.

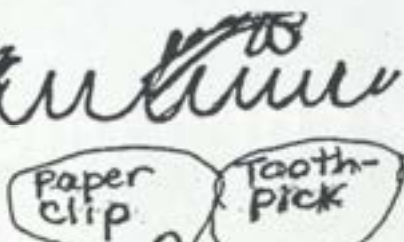
Then Paper Clip said, "Get out of here. This is our story."
